## It is further ordered that:-

The term of office of the non-official members of the Biodiversity Council shall be for a period of three years from the date of issue of the order;



ii) The office of the Jammu and Kashmir Biodiversity Council shall be at the place designated for the purpose by the Competent Authority;

## The terms of reference of the Council shall be as under:-

- i) The Council shall function as per the provisions of the Biological Diversity Act, 2002 (Central Act 18 of 2003) and the Biological Diversity Rules, 2004;
- ii) The Council shall constitute a fund, after concurrence of the Finance Department, which shall be known as "Jammu and Kashmir Biodiversity Council Fund" and all the fees, charges and benefit sharing amount received by the Council shall be credited to it. The amount so received in the Fund shall be used only for the purposes mentioned in section 27(2) of the Biological Diversity Act, 2002;
- iii) The Council shall perform the functions within the jurisdiction of the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir;
- iv) The Council shall, in consultation with the National Biodiversity Authority, notify the format and procedures for seeking approvals as required under Section 7 of the Act.
