Sub: Imposition of Night Curfew (Corona curfew) in eight districts from 10 pm to 6 am - regarding

Government Order No. 16-JK (DMRRR) of 2021.

Dated: 08.04.2021

- 1) Whereas, a detailed review of the current COVID situation in Jammu and Kashmir was conducted with the Financial Commissioner, Health; Administrative Secretary School Education; Divisional Commissioner, Jammu/Kashmir and other officers, particularly on the following:
  - a. An overall assessment of the situation pertaining to the spread of COVID-19 in Jammu and Kashmir,
  - b. The trend in new cases particularly the recent spike in the number of daily reported cases of infection in some districts of J&K.
- On the basis of the above assessment, the State Executive Committee, in exercise of the powers conferred up on it under section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, hereby orders that –
  - a) Corona Curfew shall be imposed from 10 pm to 6 am at night in urban areas of eight districts affected by the recent COVID spike. These districts are Jammu, Udhampur, Kathua, Srinagar, Baramulla, Budgam, Anantnag and Kupwara.
  - b) It shall be enforced within the municipal limits / limits of the urban local bodies of these districts, w.e.f. 09/04/21.



- c) District Reasi will remain under close observation for any possible spikes in cases.
- d) All District Magistrates will issue orders under section 144 of CrPC accordingly.
- e) It is clarified that the passengers coming via trains shall not be affected by the above restrictions.
